**Stretched Canvas or Canvas Board:** One 11”X14” or 12” X 16” (Advanced students 16”X20”)

**Easel:** Provided by Jon

**A Paint Box:** to carry your paint supplies

**Brushes:** **Robert Simmons Series 42 “Signet” Filberts** #2, 06854; #4, 06856; #6, 06858; #8, 06860  
**One small pointed water color brush** (for details and signature) #61910  
**One large round soft bristle water color brush** for blending, 1/2 to 3/4” Mop brush

**Palette:** 12”X16” or larger - Store bought or (Homemade: 1/4” birch plywood - with two coats of shellac)

**Palette Knife:** #77296 (looks like a small brick layers trowel blade)

**Painting Medium** – Winsor & Newton Liquin Original 8 oz. #07883; 16 oz. #07884

**Silicoil Brush Cleaning Tank #13508** or a Cleaning Jar with lid

**Low Oder Mineral Spirits** to clean brushes: Available at ACE Hardware, Lowe’s and Home Depot

**Paper towels** (1 roll per class)

**Sketch book and Note Pad:** *“Your sketch book may be used to practice drawing a particular subject with my instruction. I strongly encourage my students to get into the habit of drawing anything and everything. All painting is built on a foundation of drawing. I also recommend you have a note pad for writing down the color mixes.” Jon*
