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IMPORTANT: This is a reference of how to place paints on your palette.

Palette Order Left to Right:

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LANDSCAPE OIL PAINTING

Emerald Green (Rembrandt)
Permanent Green Deep (Holbein)
Turquoise (Rembrandt)
White: Zinc White (Flake White Recommended)
Lemon Yellow (W&N Winton)
Cadmium Yellow (W&N Winton)
Cadmium Orange (W&N Winton)
Cadmium Red Light (W&N Winton)
Cadmium Red Medium (W&N Winton)
Thalo Red Rose or Cadmium Red Deep (W&N Winton)
Cobalt Blue (W&N Winton)
Yellow Ochre (W&N Winton)
Raw Sienna (W&N Winton)
Burnt Sienna (W&N Winton)

PORTRAIT OIL PAINTING

Emerald Green (Rembrandt)
Permanent Green Deep (Holbein)
Turquoise (Rembrandt)
White (W&N Winton Flake or Zinc White)
Thalo Red Rose or Cadmium Red Deep (W&N Winton)
Cobalt Blue (W&N Winton)
Yellow Ochre (W&N Winton)
Raw Sienna (W&N Winton)
Burnt Sienna (W&N Winton)
Raw Umber (W&N Winton)
(Any other colors: optional)

Stretched Canvas or Canvas Board: One 11"X14" or 12" X 16" (Advanced students 16"X20" or larger)

Brushes: **Robert Simmons Series 42 "Signet" Filberts #2; #4; #6; #8**

One small pointed water color brush (for details and signature)

One large round soft bristle water color brush for blending, 1/2 to 3/4" Mop brush

Palette: 12"X16" or larger store bought or (Homemade 1/4" birch plywood - with two coats of shellac)

Paint Box for supplies and Easel (standing or table type)

Palette Knife: (the kind that looks like a small brick layers trowel, 1 1/4" to 1 3/4" blade)

Painting Medium: Winsor Newton Liquin Original painting medium for oils

Silcoil Brush Cleaning Tank or a Cleaning Jar with Lid

Low Odeur Mineral Spirits to clean brushes: Available at ACE Hardware, Lowe's, and Home Depot

Sketch book and Note Pad: *"Your sketch book may be used to practice drawing a particular subject with my instruction. I strongly encourage my students to get into the habit of drawing anything and everything. All painting is built on a foundation of drawing. I also recommend you have a note pad for writing down the color mixes."* *Jon*
